SUBJECT: Authorization to Roll Sleeves on the Army Combat Uniform (ACU)

- 1. Reference: Department of the Army pamphlet (DA Pam) 670-1, Guide to the Wear and Appearance of the Army Uniforms and Insignia, 1 July 2015.
- 2. Effective immediately, Commanders may authorize Soldiers to roll-up the sleeves on the universal camouflage pattern (UCP) ACU, operational camouflage pattern (OCP) ACU or operation enduring freedom camouflage pattern (OEF-CP) ACU. When Soldiers wear the sleeves of the ACU coat rolled up, the camouflage pattern will remain exposed. Personnel will roll sleeves neatly above the elbow but no more than 3 inches above the elbow. Upon approval of the commander and only during field training exercises, the sleeves may be down and cuffed inside the coat.
- 3. This authorization serves as an exception to DA Pam 670-1, paragraph 4-8d and is rescinded upon publication of any revision of DA Pam 670-1.
